The 5th EFEE world conference, Budapest April 2009 [BACK]

The Budapest Conference was a success, this despite the dark clouds over the world economy for the time being. The 5th EFEE world conference involved delegates, companies, joining more than 250 participants from 45 countries.

During the two days of the conference, the participants had the opportunity to listen to and discuss more then 36 papers concerning training and experiences in the field of blasting, the newest technologies and techniques concerning explosive and blasting. The papers where contributed by a mixture of companies, cooperatives, universities and educational institutions, privates and authorities from around the world, all joining to share their skills and enhancing their knowledge in the field of explosives. The initial workshop had 50 participants attending two different presentations, dealing with Electronic Detonators and Applications of Explosives in Compaction, Welding and Metal Forming. Among the 32 companies and organizations that exhibited their products and ideas, a brief interview by the EFEE newsletter revealed that a large majority where very positive to the conference and exhibition, as stated by one of the exhibitors: "Despite the economical downturn, EFEE has succeeded to draw together an interested crowd. The participants all seams very focused and we have already managed to talk to existing costumers and established contact to new once".

UK strengthening the European Federation of Explosive Engineers

The Institute of Explosives Engineers (IExpE) is happy to have rejoined EFEE at a time when there is so much happening with training and qualifications across the explosives sector and across Europe. IExpE is now a Professional Affiliate of the Engineering Council of the United Kingdom. This has opened up the possibility of our suitably qualified members gaining an engineering qualification that is recognised across the engineering professions, not only in the UK but around the world. This will identify them as having a professionally recognised competence and will improve their career prospects. There are three qualifications possible: Engineering Technician (Eng Tech), Incorporated Engineer (IEng) and Chartered Engineer (CEng).

The route to these qualifications will be linked to the work that is being done to develop explosives related Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCFs) that are replacing National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs) in the United Kingdom.



At this stage it is worth noting that the membership of IExpE is about 1000 individual members from across the explosives sector covering demolition, mining, quarrying, EOD, research, forensics, firework display organisers and special effects to name but a few. All our members gain entry by demonstrating their explosives competence by exam or work supported by references.

IExpE also has branches in Australia and Singapore and members in many countries. While the EFEE conference was being held in Budapest we had own our own AGM and Conference and the photograph shows some of our members engrossed in one of the presentations. The conference was held at the Fire Services College in Moreton in Marsh in the Cotswolds.
