What material was involved?	Bulk Emulsion (Division 5.1), Sodium Nitrite			
What happened?	After loading emulsion into a transport vehicle, foaming was noted from the hatch after driving a short distance. The driver inspected the tank, and noticed a chemical reaction was occurring. Internal experts were consulted, water was added to the tank, and the vehicle parked in a safe location with the hatch open to prevent pressure build-up.			
Why did it happen – theory?	Sodium nitrite contamination of the emulsion compartment was suspected, although no cause for the contamination could be determined.			
What was the impact?	The load was discharged to waste.
